1. INTRODUCTION

The Members of Parliament Salaries (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2020 were tabled by the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Parliamentary Affairs before the House on the 27th November, 2020. Pursuant to Standing Order No. 100(3), the Subordinate Law was then referred to the Portfolio Committee on the Prime Minister's Ministries and Departments Cluster for consideration.

The Hon. Minister was subsequently invited to provide the Committee with necessary information pertaining to the policy context, financial implications, contents, and effects of the Regulations as per Standing Order No. 101(2).

The Report presents a summary of the Committee's deliberations on the Regulations and its recommendations for consideration by the House.

2. MINISTERIAL BRIEFING ON THE SUBORDINATE LAW

The Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Parliamentary Affairs stated that Members of Parliament Salaries (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2020 are intended to repeal and replace the 2020 Regulations. The aim is to review Members' Allowances.

3. CONSIDERATION OF THE SUBORDINATE LAWS

Following a comprehensive briefing, the Committee resolved to allow all provisions of the Subordinate Law.

4. RESOLUTIONS

The Committee resolved that Members of Parliament should be paid a tax-free petrol allowance as part of salary package like other allowances.

5. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee therefore recommends that these Regulations be allowed and the Report be adopted by the House.
